CLICK BEFORE YOU DIG

Whether landscaping, building a new fence, or simply planting a garden, disturbing the ground on your property can cause damage to the buried utilities. This is a *free* service for the homeowner, however, without a locate request, the result of contacting the buried utility can be a costly repair to the homeowner, a loss of essential services to the homeowner or your neighbors, and most importantly, serious injury or death.
